







Action taken on the basis of analysis of the SSS for the session 2020-2021

The total response of 300 students were compiled and analysed by the IQAC. After thorough analysis IQAC pointed out some weakness on the part of the institution and took proper remedial measures:

We could not provide adequate interactive classes to our students due to lack of sufficient ICT classroom in our campus since our college is shared by other colleges too and we do not have exclusive classrooms for the evening section. IQAC addressed this issue to the college authority and we are trying to resolve it as soon as possible.

Students require more specific attention on one to one basis to identify their weakness and for this mentoring system should be introduced on regular basis. IQAC is looking forward to implement mentor-mentee system by maintaining register and allocating students in groups to one teacher.
