Since at least 8 members are required for the registration for the Alumni Association, so the members are requested to take initiative about this.

Library Discussion has been made on the distribution of weightages across 7 criteria and 34 key indicators (KIs) Key Indicators 1.1 is not applicable for affiliated Colleges. Since we have no Diploma Course so for KIs 1.1we can cover only 10 marks out of 20.

For criteria (1) Curricular Aspects we may cover 70 out of 100.

For criteria (2) Teaching-Learning and Evaluation we can cover up to 340 marks out of 350.

For criteria (3) Research Innovation and Extension this has been thoroughly discussed and since till now we have no extension activities (3.6) which contains 60 marks, we need to think and resolve it. Moreover, emphasis has been given to take initiative on Faculty exchange programme with other colleges, signing MOU with other institutions and research projects by the teachers.

For criteria (4) Infrastructure and Learning Resources, we have some deficiency in the Library which will be resolved very shortly and then we can cover up the marks. Dr. Amit Das is assigned for supervise the IT related matters.

For criteria (5) Student support and progression, Computer Science department is asked to make a structure so that data for every semester students should be uploaded at the departmental computer. Students participating in inter college or State Level sports are advised to submit their certificate and prizes won (if any). Teaches are also requested to take initiative to find out whatever their passed out students doing job or engaged in Higher Education. We have no Alumni Engagement till now.

The other criteria (i.e. 6 and 7) will be discussed in the next meeting.
